Intercessions – August ۲۰۲۳

1. "And I tell you, everyone who acknowledges me before others, the Son of Man also will acknowledge before the angels of God" (luke YY:A).

We beseech You, Lord God, to grant us wisdom and spiritual awakening so that we walk in the Spirit witnessing to Your holy word and professing our faith in You without fear of this world's persecution, but rather seeking the victorious crown of eternal life. We pray to You, O Lord.

7. "This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him!" (Mark 9:V).
